Homily for the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ

Today the Church celebrates the feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. It is not only a commemoration of something that happened at the last supper between Jesus and his disciples; it is a celebration of our commitment to Christ and his Church, and our commitment to our faith in Christ's real presence in the Eucharist.
