Newsletter for November 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> 2021 Please note that this is a two week newsletter!

Fr. Roch Martin will be celebrating Sunday mass on November 7<sup>th</sup> Fr. Joseph will be back for mass on Saturday November 14<sup>th</sup> Saturday and weekday masses will resume after November 14<sup>th</sup>

Information from our Public Health Office.

Please, adhere to the following advice:

- the importance of active screening everyone who enters our parishes (this requires a volunteer asking screening questions)
- the value of at least 6' between people (not between pews a body adds about 1' of space)
- hand sanitizer before entry into church and before communion (please bring your own from home if possible to use before communion). If you forget, please proceed to the back of the church to sanitize your hands first and then you can receive communion from Fr. Joseph)
- no congregational singing
- and a solid exit strategy so that people are at least 6' apart. Please remain in your pew until you can remain 6 feet away from the next parishioner.

We cannot emphasize enough how valuable these measures are, especially at a time when variants of concern are in the communities served by our diocese.

Attendance will be limited. The maximum capacity of each church is reduced to 50% fire code capacity, or fewer if required to ensure physical distancing.

Physical Distancing must be consistently practiced. Expect that your parish church will have pews/rows that are sectioned off, and that family groups and individuals will be asked to keep at least two meters (six feet) distance from each other. Wear a mask to Mass to guard against germ spread. Anyone presenting symptoms of illness or who have travelled out of country in the past 14 days is directed to stay home.

Liturgical changes will be in place. Similar to protocols established when churches were closing, extra precautions will be taken. Temporary adjustments will be made with respect to how we celebrate Mass and receive Holy Communion.

There still will be a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass. Even with best health practices and strict physical distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the corona virus. Improved cleaning will occur in our churches, but no one should expect that they will be any safer from germs than in other public spaces.

3) Signing up for a PADP - pre-authorized donation program (contact office for the form)



### A MESSAGE FOR YOU: URGENT NEED FOR APOSTLES OF PURGATORY

The world is in urgent needof "Apostles of Purgatory" to speak on behalf of the Souls in Purgatory, to plead their cause and be their liberators. If we could see the power of our sacrifices and the Masses offered for the Holy Souls, we would devote ourselves with such earnestness that the whole world would raise their eyes, take notice and would believe. The Souls in Purgatory are silent voices that beg and implore our help. They are forever crying out to the living, "Have mercy on us."

We need to <u>FULLFILL OUR DUTY AS CHRISTIANS</u>, to honor the memory of the dead, to offer prayers and suffrages for them, and to become holy as the saints are holy. Let's be examples to our family members because, let's face it, one day we will want others to pray for us.

So, it is from us alone that the Holy Souls in Purgatory expect relief. We are their only resource. We alone are their deliverers, for we alone can suffer with merit and release them. Heaven encourages them; we deliver them. Here are suggestions of prayers, indulgences and devotions. Time is of the essence. PLEASE use them.

- Consider buying Masses once a month for the Souls in Purgatory.
- Pray the Rosary and consider adding an extra decade for the Holy Souls as suggested by Saint Bernadette.
- Take a "prayer stroll" through the cemetery to pray for all those buried there. Bring holy water to sprinkle on the graves. (It is one of the first sacramentals of the Church. Holy Water refreshes the Holy Souls.)
- Replace each Hail Mary in the Rosary with Eternal Rest Prayer: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and all the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen
- Fast on Fridays in honor of our Lord's Passion. Try different fasting: no coffee, no TV...
- Pray for 10 minutes before and after Mass in thanksgiving to Jesus and for all your ancestors who have gone before you.
- Light blessed candles. The burning of a candle is a sign of our prayer, a bright, silent intercessor for the Holy Souls.
- It was revealed to a chosen soul that when one offers up the Stations of the Cross for the Souls in Purgatory, 10,000 souls are released.
- Donate on behalf of the Holy Souls.
- For our Pope and for his intentions, pray 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary, 1 Glory Be. (indulgence)
- Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You. (indulgence)
- Merciful Jesus, give them eternal rest. (indulgence)
- Jesus, Mary, I love You, save souls. (indulgence)
- Father, I offer You all our Lord Jesus' wounds to heal all souls. (indulgence)
- Visit a cemetery and pray for the souls in purgatory. (indulgence that can be gained each day between November 1-8)
