



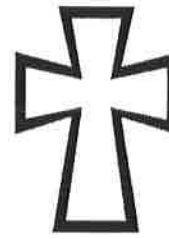

Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Friday, 25 March, during the Celebration of Penance that he will preside over at 5pm in St Peter's Basilica. "The same act, on the same day, will be performed in Fatima by Cardinal Konrad Krajewski, papal almoner," who is being sent there by the Pope. The day of the Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord was chosen for the consecration. Please join in praying this Novena each day from March 16 to March 25.

Annunciation Novena: This Novena for the feast of the Annunciation is traditionally prayed from starting on March 16th but you can pray it any time. This feast is commemorating when the angel of the Lord appeared to Mary and told her that she would conceive Jesus. It's 9 months before Christmas.

Bishop Dowd has issued a new General Decree. The *General Decree: Public Health and Safety within the Catholic Institutions During the COVID-19 Pandemic* is now published on the diocesan website:

After consultation with the *Assembly of Catholic Bishops of Ontario* (ACBO), the diocese is moving forward with the decision that masks will no longer be mandatory in churches as of Monday, March 21st, 2022. We understand that some people may wish to continue to wear their mask. We invite all those who wish to do so to feel free to continue to wear their mask. You will notice that in some circumstances the wearing of the mask remains mandatory. Please refer to Article 2 of the General Decree regarding mask requirements.

We have been receiving many inquiries regarding the Triduum celebrations. Please refer to Article 6 of the General Decree to take note of the restrictions in effect concerning particular celebrations.

Regarding receptions in the parish hall, food and beverages may be served again.

We understand that some people may feel uneasy about relaxing pandemic measures. For this reason, we invite parishes to ease into the new measures giving time for everyone to gradually become more comfortable with the loosening of the pandemic protocols in our parishes.

Bonjour!

Mgr Dowd a émis un nouveau décret général. Le *Décret général : Santé et sécurité publiques au sein des institutions catholiques pendant la pandémie de COVID-19*, est présentement publié sur le site web du diocèse : <https://diocesedesaultstemarie.org/decrets>

Après avoir consulté l'*Assemblée des évêques catholiques de l'Ontario* (AÉCO), le diocèse va de l'avant avec la décision selon laquelle les masques ne seront plus obligatoires dans les églises à compter du lundi 21 mars 2022. Nous comprenons que certaines personnes voudront continuer à porter leur masque. Nous invitons tous ceux et toutes celles qui souhaitent continuer à porter le masque à se sentir libres de le faire. Vous remarquerez que dans certaines circonstances le port du masque demeure encore obligatoire. Veuillez vous référer à l'article 2 du décret général pour les précisions à ce sujet.

Nous avons reçu plusieurs questions au sujet des célébrations du Triduum. Veuillez vous référer à l'article 6 du décret général pour prendre note des restrictions en vigueur au sujet de certaines célébrations liturgiques particulières.

Concernant les réceptions dans la salle paroissiale, les repas et breuvages pourront être servis à nouveau.

Nous comprenons que certaines personnes puissent se sentir mal à l'aise avec l'assouplissement des mesures de la pandémie. Pour cette raison, nous demandons aux paroisses d'aller de l'avant progressivement dans l'assouplissement des mesures de la pandémie permettant aux paroissiens et aux paroissiennes de s'acclimater graduellement à l'assouplissement des protocoles de la pandémie dans nos paroisses.

I am listing a few areas of interest on the General Decree:

- Masks must be worn by both the priest and the penitent when using the confessional
- Masks are not required for a person to be allowed to participate in church services and celebrations. However, anyone who wishes to wear a mask may continue to do so.
- Eucharistic ministers must continue to wear masks when distributing communion.
- Collection baskets will remain at the back of the church.. Passing the collection basket from person to person remains forbidden
- The procession with the gifts make take place.
- The Greeting of Peace is maintained, no sign such as shaking hands is permitted.
- All Eucharistic ministers are to sanitize their hands before distributing the Eucharist.
- Communion may be received directly on the tongue, but only at the end of the communion procession. The Eucharistic minister must sanitize his or her hands between each person.
- For Holy Thursday, the washing of the feet is permitted, but communion will remain under one species for the faithful.
- For Good Friday, the veneration of the cross may take place at the usual time in the ritual, including the procession. Alternatively, the veneration may take place outside the church after the ritual has completed, so that people can venerate individually as they leave the service. The actual act of veneration should not involve touching the cross or kissing it. Alternative acts of veneration such as a bow or making the sign of the cross can be suggested to the people.
- Receptions for funerals may take place in churches and church halls, as before the pandemic.
