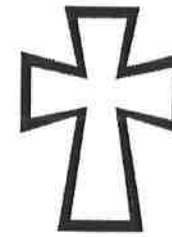

Just a reminder:

- Masks must be worn by both the priest and the penitent when using the confessional
- Masks are not required for a person to be allowed to participate in church services and celebrations. However, anyone who wishes to wear a mask may continue to do so.
- Eucharistic ministers must continue to wear masks when distributing communion.
- Collection baskets will remain at the back of the church.. Passing the collection basket from person to person remains forbidden
- The procession with the gifts make take place.
- The Greeting of Peace is maintained, no sign such as shaking hands is permitted.
- All Eucharistic ministers are to sanitize their hands before distributing the Eucharist.
- Communion may be received directly on the tongue, but only at the end of the communion procession.
- The Eucharistic minister must sanitize his or her hands between each person.

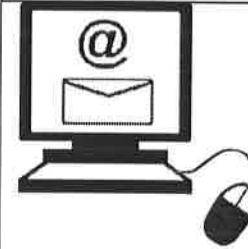
