- •Collection baskets will remain at the back of the church.. Passing the collection basket from person to person remains forbidden
- •The procession with the gifts make take place.
- •The Greeting of Peace is maintained, no sign such as shaking hands is permitted.
- All Eucharistic ministers are to sanitize their hands before distributing the Eucharist.
- •Communion may be received directly on the tongue, but only at the end of the communion procession.
- •The Eucharistic minister must sanitize his or her hands between each person.
