

As promised, here is the first part of the Mass explained to truly make the most of it:

### HOW TO PREPARE FOR MASS

When you go on a date, you prepare yourself both physically and mentally, and you don't arrive at the last minute. In the same way, when you go meet your Beloved Jesus, preparation matters. Sometimes we arrive late or begin talking and catching up with our friends in the community. While belonging to a Christian family is a beautiful gift, social time is best saved for after Mass. You should never come to Mass as though it were an ordinary event or merely part of your Sunday routine, because we come to encounter Jesus Himself.

Mother Mary said to Catalina: *Arrive early. It is important to spend time in silence and prayer, one-on-one with Jesus, before taking part in the greatest of miracles. Become aware and joyful, knowing that you're about to live the moment when the Most High God gives us His greatest gift. Begin simply by greeting the Lord – tell Him you are happy to be there and grateful to spend time with Him. Ask God to send His Holy Spirit to grant you peace and to cleanse your heart of worldly worries and distractions, so you may fully enter into this sacred moment. Pray also that the graces you receive may be extended to those you love who are not attending Mass. Take this precious time to ask for blessings for yourself, for all who are present, for the parish priest, and for the entire Church.*
