



Greetings, my beloved!

Let us continue our reflection on the Holy Mass.

The Mass begins with a **procession**, which signifies the community becoming one body and one spirit in Christ. Bowing before the altar symbolizes that God is present among us, and the Cross is carried forward as a reminder that Jesus gave His life to save us.

Confession is a beautiful and liberating opportunity that allows us to heal and cleanse the souls. Through it, we ask for and receive forgiveness for our sins, repairing our relationship with God and allowing us to live in His light. Regular confession is essential for spiritual growth and progress in our faith. At Mass, we begin the Eucharist by acknowledging our unworthiness and humbly reciting the **Penitential Prayer**.

Mother Mary said to Catalina: *From the bottom of your heart ask the Lord’s forgiveness for all your faults, for having offended Him. In this way you will be able to participate worthily in this great privilege of attending Holy Mass.*

Now that God has forgiven our sins, we worship and glorify Him by reciting the **Glory to God** prayer, inspired by the angels’ song to the shepherds on Christmas night.

Mother Mary said to Catalina: *Glorify and bless the Most Holy Trinity with all your love, acknowledging that you are one of His creatures.*

We can imagine ourselves standing before the Majestic Throne of God and pray: **“My heart belongs to You. Send me Your peace, my Lord, so that I may fully benefit from this Eucharist and bear abundant fruit. Holy Spirit, transform me and guide me. O God, give me the gifts I need to serve You better. Amen”**

The Entrance rite concludes with the **Collect**, a prayer that gathers the intentions of all who are present. You might pray: **“Heavenly Father, not all my family are here. Please make me a channel so that the graces of this Mass may also bring Your blessings to them.”**
