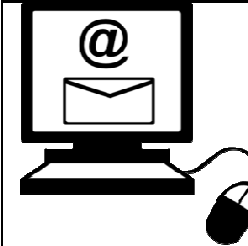

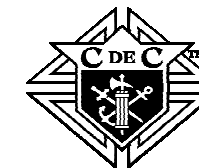

Greetings, my beloved!

Today, let us focus on the **Liturgy of the Word**. The Bible tells us the story of God’s love for humanity. The First Reading, from the Old Testament, was written before the birth of Jesus and is connected to the Gospel. The Responsorial Psalm helps us to reflect on and respond to what we have heard. The Second Reading, usually from a letter written by an apostle, offers guidance, encouragement or warnings to the early Christian communities.

The Gospel, found in the New Testament, proclaims the words and actions of Jesus Himself. We stand out of reverence and trace the sign of the cross on our forehead, lips, and heart to show that the Gospel should guide our thoughts, words, and feelings, that we seek to understand it with our minds, proclaim it with our lips, and keep it in our hearts.

The entire New Testament points to the Eucharist. In the Liturgy of the Word, we are nourished by Sacred Scripture and give glory to God through attentive listening. We learn who Jesus is and how He calls us to live. These readings prepare us for His self-gift in the Eucharist, where He comes to us as the risen Christ. In Holy Communion, we receive the strength, grace, and spiritual nourishment needed to live out His teachings. Listen to the Gospel and reflect on how to apply it to your life because it challenges us to rearrange priorities and with every act of love and every sacrifice, our capacity to love grows.

Mother Mary said to Catalina : *Be attentive to the readings and the homily. Remember that the Word of God never returns without bearing fruit. If you listen carefully, something will remain with you, perhaps two verses, the whole Gospel, or even a single word. Recall it throughout the day, savor it, and it will transform you. Tell God that you are here to listen to what He wants to say to your heart today.*

Catalina prayed this way: **“Thank you Lord for giving me the opportunity to hear Your Word. Forgive me for the times I attended Mass only out of obligation. Help me to fully live the celebration and to listen attentively to what You want to teach me today. Amen”**
