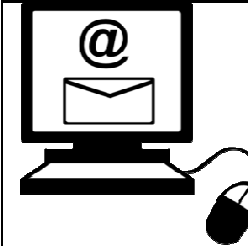

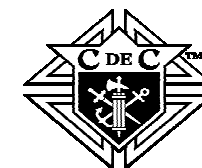
**KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FUNDRAISER

During **Catholic Education Week (May 3-8, 2026)**, the Catholic community throughout Ontario is invited to give thanks and celebrate the precious gift of publicly funded Catholic education. This year's Catholic Education Week theme, **PILGRIMS OF HOPE: ON THE PATH TO HOLINESS**, was inspired by: The Pilgrims of Hope Jubilee Year's encouragement to serve the common good and pledge to recommit ourselves to prayer, service and evangelization.

Greetings, my beloved!

Let us continue our explanation of the Mass.

After listening to the readings, the Gospel and the Homily, we respond by proclaiming the **Profession of Faith** or the **Credo** (a Latin word meaning "I believe"). Standing together, we profess as a community that we accept and believe the Word of God we have just heard. By reciting it together, we affirm that our faith is not private but shared with the whole Church. The Credo summarizes the essential truths of our faith: belief in the Trinity, the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, the Church, the forgiveness of sins, and eternal life. In proclaiming it, we also renew the faith first professed at our Baptism and reaffirm our commitment to live as disciples of Christ. The Credo prepares our hearts and minds for the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In short, the Credo is recited at Mass so that, having heard God speak to us, we may stand and proclaim together: *"This is what we believe."*

We now continue with the **Universal Prayer**, also called the **Prayer of the Faithful** or the **General Intercessions**. Having listened to Scripture and proclaimed our faith, we now respond by placing the needs of others before God.

The intentions often include those of the Church, public authorities and the world, those in need or suffering, local community, the sick...

Through Baptism, all Christians share in Christ's priestly mission. In the Universal Prayer, the faithful act as intercessors, praying on behalf of the entire human family.

By presenting these petitions, we acknowledge our dependence on God and trust that He hears and answers our prayers according to His will.

Praying for others opens our hearts in charity and prepares us to enter the Liturgy of the Eucharist united as one body in Christ.

We also remember that we have an advocate standing beside Jesus in Heaven: Mother Mary, who brings our prayers to the throne of the Heavenly Father.

In short, the Universal Prayer allows the Church, gathered as one people, to lift up the needs of the world to God with faith, hope, and love.
