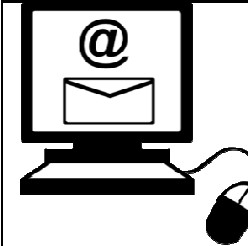

Greetings, my beloved!

We are now at the **Liturgy of the Eucharist**. Eucharist means thanksgiving because Jesus gave thanks over the bread and wine at the Last Supper. The Eucharistic Prayer is a prayer of praise in which we celebrate Jesus' death and resurrection and ask the Holy Spirit to act in our heart and in the Church.

When Jesus gave the Eucharist, He performed 4 gestures:

PART 1 – HE TOOK THE BREAD (OFFERTORY PROCESSION)

“Taken” means chosen. We too are chosen through Baptism. Like the disciples who prepared the Passover, we prepare by bringing wine and bread - the fruits of the earth to the altar; the collection is also the fruit of our labor. Then, not only do the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ, but our personal offerings gain divine value and become holy and pleasing to God. This requires faith; without it, the act would be reduced to a mere historical commemoration of the Last Supper—a symbolic recalling of a past meal rather than a present participation in its saving reality. Jesus Christ, the Lamb of the New Covenant, freely offered Himself as a true and efficacious sacrifice for our salvation.

Mother Mary said to Catalina: *Ask your guardian angel to bring your offering so it may be presented with Jesus' own self-offering. Guardian angels line up in procession to bring up all our offerings before the altar of the Lord. Because the Mass has infinite value, we should be generous in what we offer and in what we ask. Some angels, however, come sadly empty-handed—the angels of those who are present but offer nothing. All the heavenly beings bow before the altar and present their gifts. When we offer ourselves to God in this way, He is greatly pleased, and when Jesus comes down, He transforms us by His merits. All the heavenly beings bow before the altar and present their gifts.*

Example of a prayer of offering: **“Dear guardian angel, please bring my offering to God. Lord, I offer You all that I am and all that I have. I ask that one drop of Your Precious Blood be applied for the forgiveness of my sins, the conversion of sinners, my physical, emotional, and spiritual needs, my family, those who serve You, all who need prayers, and for peace in the world. Upon the holy paten, I place the Pope's intentions and all the souls in Purgatory, that You may grant them eternal rest. Precious Blood of Jesus, save us and the whole world.”**
