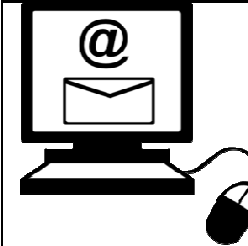

#### Eucharistic Prayer PART 2 A – **BLESSING BY THANKING**

We give thanks through Jesus at the Last Supper and conclude with the Sanctus: Holy, Holy, Holy... Mary showed Catalina that during the Sanctus, thousands of angels surround the altar in reverence, joined by the saints, the blessed in Heaven, the souls of our relatives, and Mary herself, standing behind the priest. This honor is given because the priest alone can perform the daily miracle of the Eucharist. Souls in Purgatory are also present, awaiting our prayers for they cannot pray for themselves.

At the **Consecration**, the priest calls down the **Holy Spirit** saying: “Let your Spirit come upon these gifts to make them holy so that they can become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.” Their appearance remains the same, but their substance is transformed.

The priest says: “Take this, all of you and eat of it, for this is my Body which will be given up for you.” Jesus did not say that this is symbolic. He gave a clear, direct command.

Mother Mary said to Catalina: *At this moment Jesus is looking at His people. Don't look down immediately but first, contemplate Him and repeat the Fatima prayer before bowing your head:* **“Lord, I believe, I adore, I trust and I love You. I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust and do not love You. My Lord and my God, purify me so I may receive you!”**

OR

**“I love You my Lord and my King. I trust in You, Jesus.”**

The priest says: “Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood...”

Mary said to Catalina: *At the moment of Consecration, we are taken to the foot of Calvary, to the moment of Jesus' crucifixion, when he asks for God's forgiveness, for those who put Him to death and for all our sins as He said, “Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.” Before bowing your head, say this prayer:* **“Jesus, as I receive your Body and your Blood, let them purify me and make me whole so that I may love with Your love.”**
