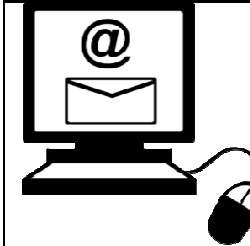

One day, Saint Lucia Filippini was making her way to Pitigliano near Grosseto, to supervise a school for craftsmen which she had founded. First, however, she stopped at the church of the Franciscan Fathers to attend Holy Mass. So great was Lucia’s desire to receive Jesus in the Eucharist that the Lord wished to reward her with a miracle. When the priest was breaking the large Host in half to place a small fragment in the chalice, this very Part escaped his hand and flew into the air, radiating light and came to rest on the tongue of the future saint. Today, the shrine where the miracle took place is under the care of the devout Filipini Sisters.

Eucharistic Prayer PART 2 C – **BLESSING BY THANKING**

Following the GREAT AMEN, the Church invites us to reconcile with one another and to share God’s love and peace as one Body, preparing our hearts to receive Him in Holy Communion. As the Body of Christ, we go through Jesus to the heavenly Father’s throne, praying in the very words Jesus Himself gave us: the **Our Father**. The priest introduces this by saying “At the Savior’s command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say.”

Now, this is a daring thing to do for 3 reasons.

1. we're approaching God as our Father. That in baptism, we are made into the adopted sons and daughters of the Father. And so, we get to approach the Father at all times.
2. when Jesus says, "Give us this day our daily bread." He's not being redundant/repetitive. That daily bread is a Greek term that indicates give us this day our super substantial bread. Here we have our Lord in the Eucharist. This is the super substantial bread. This is the bread from heaven. This is miraculous bread. Now, what is fantastic and amazing is that every Christian who's ever prayed the Lord's prayer, every one of us have been begging the Father to give us the Eucharist, give us this day our super substantial bread.
3. we dare to say, forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. What I'm basically saying is, God, my Father, only forgive me to the depth that I'm willing to forgive those who have hurt me.

Catalina heard Jesus say: *I am the Bread that came down from Heaven. I want you to pray with the deepest sincerity you can summon. Recall the person who has caused you the greatest harm during your life. Embrace that person close to your heart and say with all your heart: “**In the name of Jesus, I forgive you and wish you peace. In the name of Jesus, I ask for your forgiveness and wish my peace.**”*

Catalina felt deep sorrow as she realized how much we can hurt the Lord and injure ourselves by holding onto grudges born of prejudice and oversensitivity. She then forgave from the heart and asked for forgiveness of all whom she had hurt, and in doing so, she experienced the peace of the Lord.
