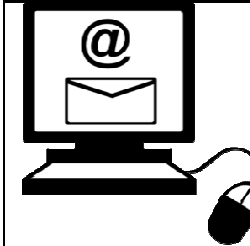

Blessed Imelda Lambertini, from childhood, already showed a great love for the Eucharistic Jesus but the chaplain reminded her that she could only receive Communion when she turned 14. Nevertheless on May 12, 1333 (Ascension Vigil), she went to Mass and presented herself to receive Holy Communion. The priest ignored her completely but the Lord wished to grant the desire of little Imelda. A Host radiating light rose up in flight, and stopped in front of Imelda. After she received the Body of Christ, her pure white soul flew straight up to heaven. Blessed Imelda is Patroness of First Communions.

Eucharistic Prayer PART 4 – **DISTRIBUTION OF THE BREAD**

All receive part of the Host, and Christ renewed in the Eucharist unites the whole Body of Christ through Holy Communion. We are that bread: chosen, blessed, broken, and distributed. **Communion is the source and summit of Christian life.** To be in communion means to be in union with Christ. Jean-Marie Vianney said, “Not to receive Communion is like dying of thirst beside a freshwater stream.”

The priest proclaims, “Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb,” and we respond with the humble words of the centurion who asked Jesus to heal the one he loved: “Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.”

Jesus asked Catalina to observe the woman who had gone to confession before Mass. When the sacred Host touched her tongue, a radiant light surrounded her. Jesus said “*This is how I rejoice in embracing a soul who comes with a clean heart to receive Me.*” Catalina reflected on how often we miss the beauty of receiving Jesus while burdened with sin, when Communion should be a feast.

Before receiving Communion, take a moment to pray:

“Mary, Mother of Jesus, teach my soul how to receive your Son in the Eucharist and how to represent Him in this world. Teach me the surrender and sacrifice that were necessary to make the Eucharist possible. Open my heart, mind and soul to a deeper understanding of the Eucharist. Intercede for me, that my heart may become ever more like His Eucharistic Heart.”

As the priest says, “The Body of Christ,” we answer “Amen.” That Amen doesn’t mean thank you. It means that I believe that this is truly Jesus. Jesus told Catalina: “*At the Last Supper I established the Eucharist, making myself a prisoner of love so I could remain with you until the end of time.*” Catalina wept while receiving Communion because she felt His immense love. Jesus then showed her a man praying only for favors, without love or gratitude. Jesus said, “*I died for love, I rose for love, and for love I remain with you. Remember that I am the Beggar of Love in this sublime hour for the soul.*”

Next time we’ll focus on prayers after receiving Communion.
