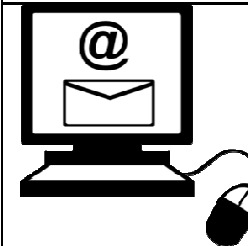

My dearly Beloved,

When the priest purifies the vessels, it is not merely washing dishes but a sacred act, because the Body and Blood of Christ are holy. Even one drop of His Precious Blood or one particle of the Eucharist is enough to save the world. Many would not name the Last Supper among history’s greatest moments, yet without it everything changes.

After Communion is a time for a thanksgiving prayer for the gift we have received. Like Mary at the Annunciation, you have welcomed Christ within you. Jesus truly dwells in you now, and this is a moment to rejoice in God and what He has done. Mary’s prayer is fitting: **“My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my Savior.”**

Here are two other examples of prayers:

My Lord and my God, I adore You. I believe that You are truly present in this holy Communion. Though I am unworthy of such a great gift, my heart overflows with gratitude that You come to dwell within me. O gentle Jesus, increase in me a deeper hunger and love for You, as I rest in Your presence and adore You in this sacred moment. Teach me to be still and to listen to Your voice. May my longing for You soothe the thirst You have for me. May this Communion strengthen my soul, heal my wounds, kindle in me a desire to serve others and fill me with Your grace. I offer this Communion for Your Holy Church, in reparation for my sins, in thanksgiving for what angels do for me, and for all those who do not come to You. Thank you for giving Your life so that I may share in eternal life. At the hour of my death, call me to Yourself, that I may praise you forever. Amen

The **ANIMA CHRISTI** prayer asks for closeness to Christ in a very personal way.

Soul of Christ, sanctify me. (Only Christ’s very life and holiness transform the soul.)
Body of Christ, save me. (A reference to the Eucharist and salvation through Jesus.)
Blood of Christ, inebriate me. (Not physical drunkenness but being overwhelmed and filled with divine grace and love.) **Water from the side of Christ, wash me.** (*Recalls the water flowing from Jesus’ side on the Cross — a symbol of Baptism, mercy, and purification.*) **Passion of Christ, strengthen me.** (*Asks for strength through meditation on Jesus’ suffering and sacrifice.*) **O good Jesus, hear me.** (*A simple cry of trust and intimacy.*) **Within Thy wounds hide me.** (*A desire to remain close to Christ, sheltered in His mercy and love.*) **Never let me be separated from You.** (*Union with Christ above all things.*)
From the evil enemy defend me. (*A prayer for protection from sin and spiritual evil.*)
At the hour of my death call me and bid me to come to You (*A request for final perseverance and a holy death.*) **that with your saints I may praise You forever and ever.** (*The prayer ends with hope in eternal life and worship in heaven.*)
